ORDER

The State Council for Vocational Education (SCVE) in its meeting held on 12-4-2005 approved the placement opportunities identified for the pass outs of VHSE courses conducted by the Vocational Higher Secondary Education Department in various Government Departments and equated posts for consideration of KPSC in addition to the courses that were already approved by the KPSC. The Government had accordingly taken up the matter with the KPSC for consideration as per the letter read above. The Secretary, KPSC in the letter read as 3rd paper above has now communicated the advice of the Commission. Government have examined the recommendations of the SCVE and the advice tendered by the KPSC in detail and are pleased to order as follows:

(i) The following seven VHSE courses will be treated as alternative qualifications for the selection in the posts in which KGTE, KGCE, ITI and NCVT are the prescribed qualification:

1. Civil Construction and Maintenance.
2. Maintenance and Repairs of Two Wheelers and Three Wheelers.
3. Maintenance and Repairs of Automobiles.
4. Maintenance and Repairs of Radio and Television.
5. Maintenance and Repairs of Domestic Appliances
6. Mechanical Servicing/Agro machinery.
7. Refrigeration and Air conditioning.

(ii) VHSE Printing Technology course will be treated as an equivalent qualification to KGTE (Higher) in Printing Technology.

(iii) Pass in the following four Vocational Higher Secondary Education courses with one year apprenticeship training will be treated as alternative qualifications for the selection to those posts for which three year Diploma (KGDE) in the respective trade is the prescribed qualification:

1. Rubber Technology
2. Textile Dyeing and Printing
3. Textile Weaving
4. Computer Science/Computer Application

(iv) VHSE in Accountancy and Auditing will be treated as an alternative qualification to KGTE Type Writing English (Lower) and ITI certificate in Stenography in English (Higher).

(v) VHSE in Office Secretary ship will be treated as an equivalent qualification to ITI certificate in Secretarial Practice and NCVT Secretarial Practice.

(vi) A pass in VHSE in Office Secretaryship with one year apprenticeship will be treated as equivalent to Diploma in Commercial Practice conducted by the Technical Education Department.

(vii) A pass in VHSE Aquaculture will be treated as an equivalent qualification to that of a pass in Higher Secondary Course from Regional Fisheries Technical High School.

(viii) A pass in VHSE course in Fishing Craft and Gear Technology will be treated as an equivalent qualification to ITI and NCVT certificates.

(ix) Two years VHSE course plus one year apprenticeship training will be treated as an alternative qualification to Diploma course or three years experience in the respective field.

The departments concerned will amend the respective Special Rules incorporating the VHSE qualifications for the selection to the posts having the equivalent or alternative qualification as indicated above.
